ASIA PACIFIC REGION

CEF World Day of Prayer - 4 November 2009, Wednesday

1. Praise the Lord for restoring Miss Jan Johnson's health. Pray for strength and stamina as she travels to different countries. Also pray for safety in flying many miles.
2. Pray for Bro VB Matthew's many travels – his safety, good health, protection and God's provisions. Pray for his family's well-being while he is away.
3. **AUSTRALIA:** Pray that God will stir the hearts of His people to see the need of reaching children and that he will raise up faithful workers. Pray for resources and personnel so that CEF can recommence in Queensland and South Australia. Pray for the national board as it seeks God's will to extend the ministry.
4. **CAMBODIA:** Pray for Mrs. Grace Lee and staff who just took on the responsibility of hosting the AP Regional Conference and National Directors Development next year. Pray for wisdom in looking after the many details of preparations.
5. **CEFRO(CH):** Pray for protection and fruitful ministry of the workers reaching children in this part of the region.
6. **CEFRO(IC):** Praises for Mien translation of Super Seminar Part 1 completed and formatted bilingual (Mien / language of Southern Territories); and for "The God Planned Life" by Mr. "O" translated into the language of the Southern Territories. Pray for completion of Mien translation of Super Seminar Part 2; translation of Super Seminar into the Hmong Language; and Consultant's travel this November to teach IOT Level 1 and 2 courses.
7. **FIJI:** Praise for the Teaching Children Effectively™ (TCE™) 1 in August with nine diligent students and for Miss Jan who was able to join the second half of the course. Pray for needed USD\$330,000.00 to construct the new CEF national office.
